Beginning February 7th

Day One will launch our 30 days of prayer with a day of fasting

Pray 7 minutes *EVERY DAY* for the 7 conferences on March 7th

On March 7th

Pray continuously from 7 AM to 7 PM for the 7 Conferences and the men returning home

Sign up for 15 minute prayer times throughout the day

To lift up the men and the speakers at all the conferences

For the Ladies, pray on site if possible

Pray for prayer requests that may come in from the men during the conference

The Intercessory Prayer
